Hazardous Waste Site Worker - \$550.00 Per Student

A (40-hour) course satisfying the OSHA initial training requirements for General Site Workers as specified in 29 CFR 1910.120 (e)(3)(i).

Note:

Students successfully completing the 40-hour Hazardous Waste Site Worker course, will also receive their **Confined Space Operations** (Compliant with OSHA 29 CFR 1910.146) and **Fall Protection** (Compliant with OSHA 1926.500 (A), 501, 502, 503) **CERTIFICATIONS AT NO ADDITIONAL COST.**

NOTE: (1) Adult First-Aid, CPR/AED training is conducted as part of this program. Students are provided a CPR breathing barrier for future emergency use.

(2) Qualitative fit-test for air purifying respirators (APRs) are available at no extra charge for students taking the course. Students must bring their personal respirators for the fit-test.

Hazardous Waste Site Worker - \$350.00 Per Student

A (24-hour) course satisfying the OSHA initial training requirements for workers other than General Site Workers (i.e., workers on-site only occasionally for a specific limited task or for workers regularly on-site, working in regularly monitored and fully characterized areas with exposures under permissible and published limits, where air-purifying respirators [APRs] are not necessary).

Complies with OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120(2)(3)(ii) & (iii)

NOTE: First Aid, CPR/AED training is also available on Thursdays in conjunction with the 40-hour program. Additional cost: \$ 75.00

This course is also offered during the same weeks as the 40-hour course and usually held on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. Call for the 24-hour course class dates when planning to register.

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Training Courses

NOTE: The EPA requires that individual medical clearances be obtained prior to attending either of the classes listed below.

Hazardous Materials Incident Response Operations (165.5) - \$550.00 Per Student

This (40-hour) course is designed for personnel involved with the investigation and remediation of uncontrolled hazardous waste sites and to a lesser extent, response to an accident involving hazardous materials. It provides basic information needed to meet the requirements of 29CFR1910.120 (e) Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response.

Class Dates: March 19-23, 2012, October 15-19, 2012

Emergency Response to Hazardous Materials Incidents (165.15) - \$550.00 Per Student

This (40-hour) course provides emergency response personnel, primarily fire fighters, police officers and emergency medical service personnel, with the information and skills needed to recognize, evaluate and control an incident involving the release or potential release of hazardous materials. It is intended for members of hazardous materials response teams and to exceed the requirements of 29CFR1910.120 (q) for Hazardous Materials Technicians.

Class Dates: April 9-13, 2012, November 26-30, 2012
